TOURNAMENT OR GAMES HOSTING AGREEMENT

In consideration of permission being granted to Portland City United Soccer Club to hold a tournament
 or games at Delta Park and Buckman Field Portland OR
(Hosting Organization) (City) (State)

On the dates of August 20-21, 20 22, we agree to the following conditions:

ABIDE BY RULES: We shall abide by all statements made in our approved US Youth Soccer *Application to Host A Tournament or Games*, in our tournament invitation, in our tournament rules, in the US Youth Soccer *Travel and Tournament Policy* and in this US Youth Soccer *Tournament or Games Hosting Agreement*. We agree that all decisions regarding acceptance of teams into a tournament shall be fairly and impartially made and shall not be based upon race, creed, color or national origin and that we will not advertise by any means the tournament or games until all approvals are received.

INVITATIONS: The tournament or games approval form shall accompany all tournament or games invitations distributed.

HOUSING: We agree that we will not require a team to use only accommodations approved or provided by the hosting organization or other organization, unless disclosure is made on the tournament application form of the required hotel/motel names and the guaranteed rates.

PROCURING LIABILITY INSURANCE: We have procured liability insurance coverage for the tournament or games with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence/\$2,000,000 aggregate and on Umbrella Liability Policy with minimum limits of not less than \$5,000,000 per occurrence/\$5,000,000 aggregate which names the State Association or Affiliate with which the Hosting Organization is a member. A copy of the certificate of insurance, IF REQUIRED, is attached issued by _____

REQUIRING MEDICAL AUTHORIZATIONS: We shall require all teams participating in the tournament or games to provide medical releases for each player in an appropriate form (paper or electronic). These authorizations shall be reviewed by the Hosting Organization at registration and kept in the possession of a team official at all times.

ADVANCE PUBLICATION OF RULES: We agree that our tournament or games rules shall be included with the invitation sent to each team and shall, again, be published to all teams accepted prior to the start of the tournament/games.

CREDENTIALS CHECKS: We agree that we shall conduct credentials checks to ensure that all players are registered with US Youth Soccer or US Soccer or a member thereof or their national association, properly rostered with their team, and participating in accordance with representations set forth on the US Youth Soccer *Application to Host a Tournament or Games*. We agree that we will not modify or mark in any way original rosters or member passes; and will not register any player, coach, or team official or issue any member pass.

USE OF US SOCCER REGISTERED REFEREES: We agree that we shall use for all games only US Soccer registered referees who are in good standing (unless US Soccer has granted a waiver to allow the use of authorized referees from another country), and shall use a one- or 3-referee system. We intend to use a 3-referee system for the following age groups: _____ . There will be an adequate number of US Soccer registered referees available in the area during the tournament or game dates to cover the scheduled games. AVAILABILITY OF POLICE AND RESCUE SERVICE: We have notified the local police, ambulance, and emergency rescue services of the date of the tournament or games and the times and fields which will be used for games, and have been advised by them that they will be available to render assistance if needed. We will use the following method(s) of contacting emergency services


TOURNAMENT OR GAME RULES – BEHAVIOR: We agree that our tournament or game rules contain provisions ensuring that the behavior of teams, players, coaches, and spectators is appropriately controlled, including specific provisions that—

- Spell out the disciplinary measures to be imposed for the issuance of red and yellow cards or other improper conduct;
- indicate what procedures will be followed regarding protests and appeals;
- indicate that all disciplinary measures imposed by hosting organizations shall be limited to placing restrictions upon an individual's group participation in the tournament/games;
- record the issuance of all red and yellow cards and other matters involving the conduct of a team, its players, coaches, and supporters and also report them immediately to the home State Association and the home club/league of the team; and
- state that the home State Association or member thereof and the home club or league shall, except in the case of referee assault or abuse, have the responsibility for imposing, should circumstances warrant, additional penalties within their respective jurisdictions with regard to any matters arising from the tournament or games.

TOURNAMENT CANCELLATION: We agree that our tournament or game rules shall state what refunds, if any, shall be made to participating teams if all or a portion of the tournament or games is cancelled by the hosting organization for any reason.


POST TOURNAMENT OR GAMES REPORT: We agree that we shall file any required Post Tournament or Games Report with the State Association or Affiliate granting us permission to host this tournament or games within 30 days after the conclusion of the tournament or games. We understand that failure to file the report may preclude the tournament/games host from receiving approval for any tournament/games for the following seasonal years until the report is filed. The Post Tournament or Games Report shall include the following information:

- the number of teams participating in each age group (boys and girls);
- if a champion is determined, the name of the champion for each group;
- the number of teams from each State Association, Affiliate, other Organization Member, or foreign country;
- if "Sportsmanship Awards" are given, the criteria for the award and to whom awards were given;
- the number of fields used for the tournament/games;
- the name of the sponsor, if any; and
- the names and teams of all players issued red and yellow cards, and details of any other matters involving the improper or unsporting conduct of a team, its players, coaches or supporters. **NOTE: Any incident of referee assault or referee abuse by a player, coach, manager, club official, or game official must be reported to the alleged offender's home State Association, or member thereof immediately, but in no event later than 48 hours after an incident of referee assault or abuse..**

Summer Classic Tournament

Rules of Competition for 2021

All matches will be played in accordance with IFAB rules, with the modifications listed below:

Game Ball:

- U8 to U12 (2012 to 2008) will use size 4
- U13 to U19 (2007 to 2001) will use size 5
- Game Ball will be provided by the tournament

Length of Games:

- U8-U10 (2010-2012) will play 25-minute halves with a 5 minute halftime
- U11-U12 (2008-2009) will play two 30-minute halves with a 5 minute halftime
- U13-U19 (2001-2007) will play two 30-minute halves with a 5 minute halftime

Rosters: Players may only be rostered on one participating team in the tournament.

- U8 - 5v5 - Roster max of 14 players
- U9/10 - 7v7 - Roster max of 14 players
- U11/12 - 9v9 - Roster max of 18 players
- U13 to U19 - 11v11 - Roster max of 22 players

No added time! The games are scheduled very tightly and unless there is an extreme situation, halves will end as scheduled. Matches designated as finals that end in a tie go immediately to kicks from the penalty mark, according to IFAB tie-breaking procedures.

Tournament Scoring System:

- 6 points for a win
- 2 points for a tie
- 1 point for each goal scored (up to 3 goals)
- 1 point for a shut out
- 10 points maximum can be scored per game. Minus 1 point for a player or coach receiving a red card for that game

Standings & Tie Breakers:

In the event of a tie in the standings, the following method will be used to resolve the tie. If more than two teams are tied, the same method will be used, starting with goal differentials, until one team is eliminated then the remaining teams will start back at the first tie breaker:

- Head to head competition
- Goal difference up to plus or minus four per game
- Goals scored up, to four per game
- Goals scored against, up to four per game
- Most shutout victories
- Coin flip by Tournament Director

Number of Players: A team which does not have seven players ready within five minutes after scheduled kickoff time, or which falls below seven players on the field at any time during the game, will forfeit the match. All matches will have a 5-minute grace period (unless extended by the Tournament Director). Failure of a team to appear on time with at least 7 players will result in a forfeit. A forfeited match will be reported as a 4-0 score against the forfeiting team.

- 5 v 5 - 4 player minimum on the field
- 7 v 7 - 5 player minimum on the field
- 9 v 9 - 6 player minimum on the field
- 11 v 11 - 7 player minimum on the field

Substitutions: Unlimited in all age groups. With the referee's permission, teams may substitute during any stoppage of play (i.e. any dead ball). There will be no limit on the number of times a player may re-enter the game. If there is more than one foreign team in your bracket IFAB substitution rules will apply.

Player Equipment/Uniforms: Referees will inspect player equipment before the game. In case of color conflict between the teams, the designated home team (the team listed first on the schedule) must change jerseys. All jerseys must be numbered. Players may not change shirts during a game except with the referee's permission. Jersey numbers are not required but recommended for U8 to U10 teams.

U8 to U10 Competition Rules: Goalkeepers are not allowed to punt or drop kick the ball. They can throw the ball or play the ball from the ground with their feet. On goal kicks the defending team must retreat to the build out line. Once the ball is played the defending team may enter the area of the field ahead of the build out line. There is not offsides until the build out line.

Heading Rules: There is no deliberate heading from U8 through U12. An indirect free-kick will result from the spot that the ball was deliberately headed.

Red Cards: Any player sent off (red card) may not participate in the next game of the tournament. If a player participates in any game for which he/she is ineligible, his or her team shall forfeit that game. If a coach is dismissed from a game they will be ineligible to coach their or any team's following match until they have served their suspension. If the player was sent off, or coach was dismissed for assault, that player or coach shall be ineligible for the remainder of the tournament.

Registration/Rosters: All players must be registered with their national youth soccer association, which is affiliated, directly or indirectly, with FIFA. All players will need a valid player card which will be checked at registration against the team roster. Players may be listed on one roster only and play with only one team. Teams may not add to their roster after the team's first game of the tournament. All USYS teams from out of the state of Oregon, Washington, and Idaho must fill out travel papers and submit them to the tournament headquarters (See Delta Park Map), before the team's first game. Your player cards must either be all US Club Soccer cards or USYS cards; you cannot mix cards for one team. Teams will be required to check-in at least 1 hour prior to their first match at the tournament headquarters. Coaches/Managers will need to keep the 4 stamped rosters and present the roster to the field marshal 30 minutes prior to each game.

Game Scores: Game scores will be collected by the field marshals from the referees.

Protests/Appeals/Refunds: All referee judgments and decisions are final! There will be no appeals. There will be no refunds after the registration deadline.

Athletic Trainers: There will be a licensed athletic trainer at Delta Park (N Denver Avenue and Martin Luther King Jr Blvd).

Lightning 30-30 Rule: Play will be suspended for 30 minutes after the last lightning strike. Game length can be affected for any/all games following a lightning strike to make sure all games are played that day. The Tournament Director will dictate the game length after lightning has occurred.

Casts: Casts made of hardened material may be worn if sufficiently padded (to the satisfaction of the referee). However, if the referee determines that the cast presents a danger to the player or others then that player may be prohibited from playing (or continuing to play).

The Tournament Director has the authority to modify or waive these rules in unusual circumstances for any games that have not yet begun. (For example, in the event of extremely hot weather, the Director may shorten or otherwise modify the games.)
